## **Findings of Fact**

- 1. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-10710 in the name of Central Oregon Irrigation District on October 29, 2008. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 76, at Page 551. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2009.
- 2. On September 14, 2010, the Department received an application for extension of time for transfer of water right T-10710 from Central Oregon Irrigation District.
- 3. The applicant has completed all changes authorized in the final order with the exception of the C.E. Phillips Family Partnership property. 1.40 acres of the 2.90 acres has been irrigated.
- 4. The C.E. Philips Family Partnership property was foreclosed in mid 2010. The property has been taken over by Michael Plunkett.
- 5. To fully complete the change, it will be necessary for the Michael Plunkett property to finish clearing and seeding the remaining acres.
- 6. The applicant has requested that the time for completion of beneficial use be extended to October 1, 2011.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

### **Conclusions of Law**

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-10710.

# Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of beneficial use authorized by T-10710 shall be extended to October 1, 2011.
