Authority

OAR 690-380-6010(6) provides that a point of diversion or appropriation shall revert to the last authorized point of diversion or appropriation if the changes authorized under a transfer are not completed.

Findings of Fact

1. On December 7, 1994, Robert S. and Diana M. Cronhardt filed an application for an additional point of diversion under Certificates 48142 and 68345. The Department assigned the application number T-7267.
2. On February 1, 1996, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving the proposed additional point of diversion. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 50, Page 62.
3. On September 23, 2015, the transfer application was partially assigned by proof of ownership to Len and Karen Damerow.
4. On January 25, 2016, Len and Karen Damerow requested that the additional point of diversion approved under Transfer Application T-7267 for Water Right Certificate 48142 be reverted back to its authorized point of diversion.
5. Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6010(6), the additional point of diversion shall revert to the last authorized point of diversion for that portion of the transfer not completed.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Conclusion of Law

The request to revert the additional point of diversion back to the authorized point of diversion under Certificate 48142 is consistent with the requirements of OAR 690-380-6010(6).

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The additional point of diversion authorized under Transfer Application T-7267 for the right described by Certificate 48142 are reverted to the point of diversion authorized under the water right prior to the transfer.
2. A superseding certificate, in the names of Len and Karen Damerow, shall be issued to describe the water right reverted.
3. All other terms and conditions of Special Order Vol. 50, pages 62-64 remain unchanged.
