
**Findings of Fact**

1. On January 4, 2016, Youth Stimulus Package, LLC filed an application for an allocation and use of conserved water under Certificates 13127 and 13178. The Department assigned the application number CW-89.
2. On January 13, 2017, the Department issued a Draft Preliminary Determination proposing to deny the application due to harm to other water rights.
3. On February 21, 2017, the Applicant submitted a request to withdraw allocation for Allocation of Conserved Water application CW-89.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-89 is withdrawn and is of no further force or effect. A refund of \$675.00, representing 50% of the fees paid, will be issued.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
