Authority

ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to temporarily transfer the place of use and, if necessary to convey the water to the temporary place of use, the point of appropriation authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On March 27, 2008, Robert Levy filed an application on behalf of L & L Farms, to temporarily change the place of use and add additional points of appropriation under Certificates 76263 and 79993 for a period of one year. The Department assigned the application number T-10581.
- 2. The first right to be transferred is as follows:

Certificate: 76263 in the name of J. R. SIMPLOT CO. (perfected under Permit G-5812)

Use: IRRIGATION of 226.1 ACRES

Priority Date: JUNE 12, 1972

Rate: 2.83 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (cfs)

Limit/Duty: ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cfs per acre, not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for

each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year **Source:** A WELL in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 11. Notice of the application for temporary transfer was published April 8, 2008, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 12. Transfer Application T-10581 proposes to temporarily transfer water rights within the boundaries of Westland Irrigation District. The district was notified of the proposed temporary transfer and did not provide any comments.
- 13. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights and there is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.

- 14. A well, pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights are present.
- 15. The proposed additional points of appropriation will develop the same source of water as the authorized point of appropriation.
- 16. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 17. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the transfer may be revoked under ORS 540.523(6) if the Department later finds that the transfer is causing injury to any existing water right.

Conclusions of Law

The temporary changes in place of use and additional points of appropriation are consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.523 and OAR 690-380-8000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The temporary changes in place of use and additional points of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-10581 are approved.
- 2. The former places of use **shall not** be irrigated as part of these water rights during the 2008 irrigation season.
- The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2008 irrigation season.
 The authorization to use the additional points of appropriation shall be terminated concurrently.
- 4. Water rights under Certificates 76051, 79439 and water use Permit S-48450 (modified under transfer application T-9845) shall not be exercised during the 2008 irrigation season at the authorized place of use as described in Findings of Fact #5.
- The use of water under this temporary transfer may be conditioned or revoked at any time to the extent necessary to avoid injury if the Department finds the transfer causes injury to any existing water right.
- 6. A subsequent application for permanent transfer of Certificates 76263 and 79993 shall be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 380. Approval of this temporary transfer does not establish a precedent for approval of a subsequent application filed for a permanent transfer.
- 7. The use of water at the temporary place of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 76263 and 79993.
- 8. The time during which water is used under this approved temporary transfer does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture under ORS 540.610.

- 9. The use of the remaining water rights described by Certificates 76263 and 79993 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 76263 and 79993.
- 10. The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement device and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.
