Findings of Fact

- 1. On June 22, 2007, R. D. Jensen and the Oregon Water Trust (*now The Freshwater Trust*) filed an Instream Lease Application, which proposed to lease all of Certificates 16125, 34514, 43252 and 50907 for instream use. The Department assigned the application number IL-853.
- 2. On August 17, 2007 the Department issued Special Order Volume 73, pages 76 through 79. which approved the Instream Lease Application IL-853.
- 3. On March 31, 2011 David Pilz of The Freshwater Trust requested the Department to a portion of Instream Lease IL-853.
- 4. On April 1, 2011 David Pilz of The Fresh Water Trust amended the termination request to include the entire lease.
- 5. Instream Lease IL-853 was exercised during the 2010 leasing season.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Department concludes that terminating the lease in advance of the 2011 irrigation season is consistent with OAR 690-077.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

ORDER

Therefore, it is ORDERED that the Instream Lease described herein is TERMINATED and no longer in effect.
