ORS 537.455 to 537.500 authorize and establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request for an allocation of conserved water. OAR Chapter 690, Division 18, implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating allocation of conserved water applications.

**Findings of Fact**

1. On January 15, 2002, Oregon Water Trust (Freshwater Trust), on behalf of Squaw Creek Irrigation District, filed an application for an Allocation and Use of Conserved Water under Certificate 74135.
2. The conservation project proposed replacing approximately 15,000 feet of the Cloverdale Ditch with a buried pipe. The project was expected to yield approximately 3.0 of conserved water. The Applicants proposed the conserved water be allocated to an instream water right.
3. Notice of the proposed conservation project was published in the Department's weekly bulletin on July 30, 2002, and in *The Bulletin* newspaper on July 24, 31, and August 7, 2002.
4. On August 29 and 30, 2002, comments were received from the Keith and Conida Cyrus, Water for Life, Oregonians in Action, Oregon Family Farm Association, Cyrus Family and the Oregon Farm Bureau Federation

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).


Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

5. On September 24, 2002, the Oregon Water Trust on behalf of Squaw Creek Irrigation District requested withdrawal of Application CW-18 for the Cloverdale ditch project.
6. There were no fees associated with the application.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-18 is withdrawn and is of no further force or effect.
