Authority

ORS 540.570 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a district may submit a request to transfer a water right within district boundaries. OAR Chapter 690, Division 385 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating district transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On February 20, 2008 the Department issued a final order approving a district permanent transfer as proposed in Transfer Application T-10514, recorded at Special Order Volume 74, page 204. The order approving T-10514 contained a scrivener error in the order caption. This order corrects that error in *bold italicized* script.
- 2. On December 31, 2007 North Unit Irrigation District filed a district transfer application to permanently change the place of use under Certificates 72279, 72281 and 72283. The Department assigned the application number T-10514.
- 3. Notice of the application for transfer was published pursuant to ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4400. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 4. The first rights to be transferred are as follows:

Certificate: 72279, issued in the name of North Unit Irrigation District.

Use: Irrigation (IR).

Priority Date: February 28, 1913.

Rate & Duty: Maximum of 1/40 cfs per acre & 5.25 acre-feet per acre per year.

Source: Deschutes River, Wickiup and Haystack Reservoirs all tributaries of the Columbia

River.

Certificate: 72281, issued in the name of North Unit Irrigation District.

Use: Supplemental Irrigation (IS). Priority Date: June 23, 1955.

Rate & Duty: Maximum of 1/40 cfs per acre & 4.0 acre-feet per acre per year.

Source: Crooked River a tributary of the Deschutes River.

- 6. The district permanent transfer application satisfies the criteria of OAR 690-385-4000, contains the information required under OAR 690-385-2000 and includes maps meeting the requirements of OAR 690-385-2200.
- 7. The water rights are subject to transfer as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(17).
- 8. The proposed changes in place of use would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 9. The proposed changes in place of use would not result in injury to other rights.

Conclusions of Law

The proposed changes in place of use in Transfer Application T-10512 satisfy the requirements of ORS 540.574(3) and 540.580.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The final order entered at Special Order Volume 74, pages 204 is void and of no further force or effect.
- 2. The proposed changes to the District's existing water right Certificates 72279, 72281 and 72283 are approved.
- 3. The right to the use of water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the District's water rights or any related decree.
- 4. The former places of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of these water rights.

- 5. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 2009.
- 6. A Claim of Beneficial Use and Final Proof Map shall be submitted by North Unit Irrigation District to the Department by October 1, 2010.
- 7. Certificates 72279, 72281 and 72283 are modified. The Department will issue a superseding certificate on a determination that it is necessary to produce a certificate describing the right.
