confirms the right of record to use the waters of from MASON RESERVOIR, tributary of SNAKE RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 151.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 50696. The date of priority is April 26, 1982.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to diversion not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from Mason Reservoir constructed under permit R-5083. The use of natural flow is limited to the period of March 1 through July 30 of each year.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.

This order is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 24, 2007, at Special Order Volume 72, Page 138, approving Transfer Application 8446, affecting a portion of Certificate 73999, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The Department will issue a superseding certificate describing the right when it determines that it is necessary for record keeping.
