Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 540.570 to 540.580 establish the process in which a district may submit a request to transfer a water right within district boundaries. Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 385 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating district transfer applications.

ORS 540.621 establishes the process for the owner of land to which a water right is appurtenant to certify under oath that the water right, or a portion thereof, has been abandoned and to voluntarily request that it be cancelled.

Applicant

Findings of Fact

- 1. On January 16, 2018, Stanfield Irrigation District (SID) filed a completed district transfer application to permanently change the place of use under Certificates 87035, 86377, 86203, and 86205. The Department assigned the application number T-12817.
- 2. Notice of the District Permanent Transfer Application was published on January 16, 2018, pursuant to ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4400. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. The U.S. Bureau of Reclamation was notified of the transfer application on January 16, 2018; no comments were received within 60 days of the notification.
- 4. On April 30, 2018, June 15 and 25, 2018, and November 2, 2018, SID submitted corrections and amended their transfer application.
- 5. The portion of the first right to be transferred is as follows:

Certificate: 87035 in the name of STANFIELD IRRIGATION DISTRICT (confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County)

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Within 20 days after this final order is issued (i.e., mailing date), the district or any protestant may file with the commission exceptions to the final order. The commission shall issue an order granting or denying the exceptions within 30 days after receiving the exceptions. ORS 540.580(10).

Use: IRRIGATION of 6.6 ACRES, DOMESTIC, AND STOCK WATER

Priority Dates: MARCH 8, 1905

Limit/Duty: The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured

under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) from March 1 to November 1 and subject to the limitations of paragraph 32 of the Umatilla River Decree for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

13. All or a portion of the authorized and proposed places of use in this transfer application are layered with Water Right Permit S-55061 which is for use of water from the Columbia River, tributary to the Pacific Ocean. Permit S-55061 has a condition (No. 2, page 32) that states if water authorized under the permit is used for supplemental irrigation, then the pre-existing primary rights for the same place of use cannot be transferred to another place of use or the character of use changed. As required under permit condition No. 16.A and 16.B. all irrigation activity under Permit S-55061 must be mapped by quarter-quarter and reported to the Department prior to February 15 of each irrigation season.

However, the permit holder has not provided any maps or records to indicate an intent to irrigate lands authorized under Permit S-55061 involved in this transfer as described in the above Findings of Facts 5 through 12. Therefore, the Department finds permit condition No. 2 does not apply to the lands involved in this transfer.

14. All or a portion of the authorized and proposed places of use in this transfer application are layered with Water Right Permit S-55114 which is for use of water from the Columbia River, tributary to the Pacific Ocean. Permit S-55114 has a condition (No. 2, page 28) that states if water authorized under the permit is used for supplemental irrigation, then the pre-existing primary rights for the same place of use cannot be transferred to another place of use or the character of use changed. As required under permit condition No. 17.A and 17.B. all irrigation activity under Permit S-55114 must be mapped by quarter-quarter and reported to the Department prior to February 15 of each irrigation season.

However, the permit holder has not provided any maps or records to indicate intent to irrigate lands authorized under Permit S-55114 involved in this transfer as described in the above

Findings of Facts 5 through 12. Therefore, the Department finds permit condition No. 2 does not apply to the lands involved in this transfer.

- 15. The Department finds that the district permanent transfer application was submitted according to ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4000, contains the information required under OARs 690-385-4200 and OAR 690-385-2000, and includes maps meeting the requirements of OARs 690-385-4300 and 690-385-2200.
- 16. The Department finds that the proposed district permanent transfer meets all the criteria set forth in ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4000.
- 17. The water right is subject to transfer as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(17).
- 18. The proposed change in places of use will not result in enlargement of the right as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(4).
- 19. The proposed change in place of use will not result in injury to other water rights as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(6).
- 20. Any other applicable requirements for district permanent water right transfers are met as required in OAR 690-385-4500.

Cancellation of Water Right Certificate 91247

Conclusions of Law

The proposed changes in place of use as proposed in Transfer Application T-12817 comply with and satisfy the requirements of ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4500 and the abandoned rights should be cancelled.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The proposed changes in place of use to the water rights evidenced by Certificates 87035, 86377, 86203, and 86205 are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use not modified by this order and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 87035, 86377, 86203, and 86205 and any related decree.
- 3. The portions of the water right as evidenced by Certificates 91246 as requested to be canceled are canceled. A new certificate will be issued confirming the balance of the right not modified by this Final Order.
- 4. The water right as evidenced by Certificates 91247 as requested to be canceled is canceled.
- 5. The proposed changes in place of use as proposed in Transfer Application T-12817 comply with and satisfy the requirements of ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4500.
- 6. The place of use from which the water right is removed by T-12817 shall no longer be irrigated under the transferred rights.
- 7. The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement device and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.
- 8. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2020**. A Claim of Beneficial Use shall be submitted by SID to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 9. Water right Certificates 87035, 86377, 86203, and 86205 are modified. The Department will issue superseding certificates describing the rights when it determines it is necessary for record keeping.
