Authority

OAR Chapter 690, Division 086, establishes the process and criteria for approving water management and conservation plans required under the conditions of permits, permit extensions and other orders of the Department.

Findings of Fact

1. Camp Rilea; Oregon Military Department (Camp Rilea) submitted a Water Management and Conservation Plan (plan) and the required statutory fee for review of the plan to the Water Resources Department (Department) on September 12, 2022, The plan was required by a condition set forth under Camp Rilea's previously approved plan (Sp. Or. Vol. 89, Pg. 121) issued on March 13, 2013.
2. The Department published notice of receipt of the plan on September 27, 2022, as required under OAR Chapter 690, Division 086. No comments were received.
3. Upon initial review, the Department found that Affected Local Government had not initially been provided with a copy of the draft plan. Camp Rilea provided a draft of the plan to Clatsop County on November 28, 2022. *ESGS # S OUA*
4. The Department provided written comments on the plan to Camp Rilea on March 27, 2023. In response, Camp Rilea submitted a revised plan on June 12, 2023.
5. The Department reviewed the revised plan and finds that the revised plan is consistent with the relevant requirements under OAR Chapter 690, Division 086.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
