**Authority**

OAR Chapter 690, Division 086, establishes the process and criteria for approving water management and conservation plans required under the conditions of permits, permit extensions and other orders of the Department.

**Findings of Fact**

1. The City of Wallowa submitted a Water Management and Conservation Plan to the Department on June 10, 2010. The plan was required by the Final Order approving an Extension of Time for Permit G-10569.
2. The Department published notice of receipt of the plan on June 15, 2010, as required under OAR Chapter 690, Division 086. No comments were received.
3. The Department provided comments on the plan to the City on August 18, 2010. In response, the City submitted revisions to the plan on September 14, 2010, and September 20, 2010.
4. The Department reviewed the revised plan and finds that the plan is generally consistent with the relevant requirements under OAR Chapter 690, Division 086.

**Conclusion of Law**

The Water Management and Conservation Plan submitted by the City of Wallowa is consistent with the criteria in OAR Chapter 690, Division 086.


**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

1. The City of Wallowa Water Management and Conservation Plan is approved and shall remain in effect until September 24, 2020, unless this approval is rescinded pursuant to OAR 690-086-0920.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

2. The City of Wallowa shall submit an updated plan meeting the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 086 (effective November 1, 2002) within 10 years and no later than September 24, 2020.
3. The City of Wallowa shall submit a progress report containing the information required under OAR 690-086-0120(4) by September 24, 2015.
