Authority

ORS 537.211 establishes the process in which a water right permit holder may submit a request to change the point of appropriation and/or place of use authorized under an existing water right permit.

Findings of Fact

Background

- 1. On December 24, 2012, TOWN OF LAKEVIEW filed an application to change the location of the production well and injection well under Permit G-16806. The Department assigned the application number T-11513.
- 2. Notice of the application for the permit amendment was published in the Department's weekly notice on January 8, 2013, and in the Lake County Examiner newspaper on June 5 and 12, 2013, pursuant to ORS 540.520(5). No comments were filed in response to the notices.
- 3. Permit Amendment Application T-11513 proposes to move the production well approximately 26 feet from the existing production well and move the injection well approximately 4930 feet from the existing injection well to:

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Permit Amendment Review Criteria

- 4. The change would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 5. The change does not enlarge the permit.
- 6. The change does not alter any other terms of the permit.

Conclusions of Law

The change in points of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-11513 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The change in points of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-11513 is approved.
- 2. Permit G-17029, in the name of TOWN OF LAKEVIEW, is issued to replace Permit G-16806, and incorporates the amendments approved by this order. Permit G-16806, in the name of TOWN OF LAKEVIEW, is no longer of any force or effect.
- 3. The quantity of water diverted at the new production well shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original production well.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original production well.
- 5. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-17029 remain the same.
