

Permit Amendment Review Criteria

4. The change would not result in injury to other water rights.
5. The change does not enlarge the permit.
6. The change does not alter any other terms of the permit.


Conclusions of Law

The change in points of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-11513 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The change in points of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-11513 is approved.
2. Permit G-17029, in the name of TOWN OF LAKEVIEW, is issued to replace Permit G-16806, and incorporates the amendments approved by this order. Permit G-16806, in the name of TOWN OF LAKEVIEW, is no longer of any force or effect.
3. The quantity of water diverted at the new production well shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original production well.
4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original production well.
5. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-17029 remain the same.
