APPROPRIATE WATER.


ORDER

WHEREAS Edward W. Coles of Haines, Oregon filed on June 4th, 1929 an application for permit to appropriate waste water from the Nancy A. Maxwell ranch for irrigation of 70 acres, said application being numbered 12765, and

WHEREAS the State Engineer has conducted a hearing and caused to be made an inspection of the premises for the purpose of determining whether or not the waters for which application is made are subject to appropriation, and as a result of such hearing and investigation, it appears that the waters sought to be appropriated are subject to appropriation as proposed by the application of Edward W. Coles and the proposed use is not in conflict with existing rights.

THEREFORE it is ORDERED that Application No. 12765 be approved and a permit issued thereon.
