

OF LEISURE DEVELOPMENT COMPANY)

Transfer Application M-202, in the name of Leisure Development Company, proposed a change in point of diversion and use of water from Crooked River under a certain right with priority dates of 1893 and April 24, 1909, to reservoir maintenance and recreation use in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 17, NE 1/4 NW 1/4 and NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 20, and irrigation in Section 18, Township 16 South, Range 16 East, WM.

The order of the Water Resources Director, entered January 18, 1979, approving Transfer Application M-202, provided: "...that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1980."

The applicant has failed to make proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director that the proposed change was accomplished within the provisions of the order, therefore, the subject water right was lost.
