ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6600 submitted by

CHARLES E. BOCHSLER
P.O. BOX 428
MT. ANGEL, OREGON 97362.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 40011, was perfected under Permit G-4206 with a date of priority of JUNE 25, 1968. The right allows the use of A WELL, a tributary of the BOCHSLER CREEK (PUDDING RIVER) BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 37.1 ACRES. The right is limited to 0.46 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 35, T 5 S, R 1 W, WM; 810 FEET SOUTH AND 410 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 35, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 9.6 ACRES
SECTION 26

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 2.6 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 24.6 ACRES
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 0.3 ACRE
SECTION 35

TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to add an additional point of appropriation to:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 26, T 5 S, R 1 W, WM; 380 FEET NORTH AND 840 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 26.


THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1996.

2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity of water diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Certificate 40011 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
