ORDER APPROVING A TEMPORARY CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.523, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TEMPORARY TRANSFER 8407 submitted by

ECHO IRRIGATION DISTRICT
P.O. BOX 110
HERMISTON, OREGON 97838.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by an order of the Water Resources Director, entered July 14, 1997, at Special Order Volume 51, Page 653, approving Transfer 7753, was perfected under Permit G-7183 with a date of priority of FEBRUARY 25, 1977. The right allows the use of TWO WELLS, in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 237.8 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.97 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW¼ SE¼, SECTION 24, T 4 N, R 28 E, WM; 1230 FEET NORTH AND 1910 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 24, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The authorized points of appropriation are located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 24, T 4 N, R 28 E, WM; WELL 2 - 1230 FEET NORTH AND 1910 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 24;

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 9, T 3 N, R 29 E, WM; SIEBEL - 380 FEET NORTH AND 3120 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

THIS TEMPORARY CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The change is temporary. The change shall be effective upon issuance of this order.
2. The former place of use shall not be irrigated as part of this water during the 2000 irrigation season.
3. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2000 irrigation season.

4. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right.
