Final Order in Other  
than a Contested Case

On November 3, 2017, the Water Resources Department issued a Final Order in other than a Contested Case described as Certificate of Water Right Number 93356. The Certificate described the extent of use of water, to the satisfaction of the Department, perfected under the terms of Transfer T-11108.

The Department is reconsidering the issuance of the above referenced certificate on its own initiative as allowed in OAR 137-004-0080(5).

FINDING OF FACT

1. On November 3, 2017, Water Right Certificate 93356 was issued and mailed.
2. Water Right Certificate 93356 is a Final Order in Other than a Contested Case.
3. Within 60 calendar days after the date of the order, the Department may, on its own initiative, reconsider the final order.
4. The Department discovered that the certificate contained a scrivener's error.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

OAR 137-004-0080(5) allows the agency, within 60 calendar days after the date of the order, to on its own initiative, reconsider the final order.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**



Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The Department hereby reconsiders and withdraws Final Order Water Right Certificate Number 93356.

Final Order Certificate Number 93356 is of no further force or effect.
