Findings of Fact

- 1. On November 8, 2018, the Department issued an order cancelling a portion of Certificate 87235. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 109, Pages 909-910.
- 2. The order contained a scrivener's error describing the location of the two wells being removed from the certificate. Finding of fact #3 in Special Order Volume 109, Pages 909-910 is corrected as follows (correction shown in **bold**):

Certificate 87235 authorizes, in part, the use of groundwater from Hole Ten Well #1 and Hole Ten Well #2, both in Township 18, South, Range 12 East, Section 20, SW1/4 NE1/4, W.M.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The final order cancelling a portion of Certificate 87235, as recorded in Special Order Volume 109, Pages 909-910 is hereby as shown in Finding of Fact #2, above.
- 2. All other provisions of Special Order Volume 109, Pages 909-910 remain in effect.
