Authority

OAR Chapter 690, Division 086, establishes the process and criteria for approving water management and conservation plans required under the conditions of permits, permit extensions and other orders of the Department.

Findings of Fact

1. The Glide Water Association (Association) submitted a Water Management and Conservation Plan (plan) and the required statutory fee for review of the plan, to the Water Resources Department (Department) on September 19, 2022. The plan was required by a condition set forth under the Association’s previously approved plan (Sp. Or. Vol. 89, Pgs. 123-124) issued on March 18, 2013.
2. The Department published notice of receipt of the plan on September 27, 2022, as required under OAR Chapter 690, Division 086. No comments were received.
3. The Department provided written comments on the plan to the Association on December 14, 2022. In response, the Association submitted a revised plan on March 13, 2023.
4. The Department provided written comments on the revised plan to the Association on July 20, 2023. In response, the Association submitted a final revised plan on May 14, 2024.
5. The Department reviewed the final revised plan and finds that the final revised plan is consistent with the relevant requirements under OAR Chapter 690, Division 086.

Conclusion of Law

The Water Management and Conservation Plan submitted by the Glide Water Association is consistent with the criteria in OAR Chapter 690, Division 086.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

Duration of Plan Approval:

1. The Glide Water Association Water Management and Conservation Plan is approved and shall remain in effect until **July 3, 2034**, unless this approval is rescinded pursuant to OAR 690-086-0920.

Development Limitation(s):

2. The limitation of the diversion of water under **Permit S-35104** established in the Final Order approving an Extension of Time for **Permit S-35104** (*issued on September 27, 2007*) remains unchanged. Subject to other limitations or conditions of the permit, therefore, the Glide Water Association remains authorized to divert only up to **0.48 cfs** (*out of the total permitted 0.5 cfs*) of water under **Permit S-35104**.
3. The limitation of the diversion of water under **Permit S-42561** established in the Final Order approving an Extension of Time for **Permit S-42561** (*issued on July 11, 2003*) remains unchanged. Subject to other limitations or conditions of the permit, therefore, the Glide Water Association remains authorized to divert only up to **0.36 cfs** (*out of the total permitted 1.5 cfs*) of water under **Permit S-42561**.

Plan Update Schedule:

4. The Glide Water Association shall submit an updated plan meeting the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 086 (effective December 23, 2018) no later than **January 3, 2034**.


Progress Report Schedule:

5. The Glide Water Association shall submit an analysis of potential water loss factors and proposed corrective actions as required under OAR 690-086-0150(4) by **July 3, 2026**.
6. The Glide Water Association shall submit a progress report containing the information required under OAR 690-086-0120(4) by **July 3, 2029**.

Other Requirements for Plan Submittal:

7. The deadline established herein for the submittal of an updated Water Management and Conservation Plan (consistent with OAR Chapter 690, Division 086) shall not relieve the Glide Water Association from any existing or future requirement(s) for submittal of a Water Management and Conservation Plan at an earlier date as established through other final orders of the Department.
