O R D E R

APPROVING APPLICATION

On April 29, 1936, the Hills Creek Lumber Company filed an application for approval of a change in point of diversion and place of use of water from Hills Creek.

Certificate of Water Right No. 9136, issued to the Hills Creek Lumber Company, confirmed an appropriation under Permit No. 8130 for the use of 2 second feet of the waters of Hills Creek for log pond and sawmill purposes in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 20, T. 18 S., R. 1 W., W. M., with a date of priority of August 9, 1927, the point of diversion under said certificate being located N. 51° 55' W. 3367.1 feet from the NW corner of Frederick Gray D. L. C. No. 38 in T. 18 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Certificate of Water Right No. 7736, issued to the Hills Creek Lumber Company, confirmed an appropriation under Permit No. 7299 for the use of 4 second feet of the waters of Hills Creek for fluming lumber, with a date of priority of August 9, 1927, the point of diversion being the same as described above under Certificate No. 9136 and terminating in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 14, T. 18 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The applicant herein proposes to change the points of diversion under said Certificates Nos. 9136 and 7736 to a point up-stream to be located 1835.4 feet S. 34° 25' W. from the NE corner of Sec. 21, T. 18 S., R. 1 W., W. M., and to change the place of use for log pond and sawmill purposes under said Certificate No. 9136 to the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 21, T. 18 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Notice was published in The Eugene Morning News, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Lane County, in the issues of May 9, May 16, May 23 and May 30.

No objections having been filed, it appears that such changes can be made without injury to existing rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that said changes in points of diversion and place of use of water be and the same are hereby approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Certificates of Water Right Nos. 9136 and 7736, heretofore issued to the Hills Creek Lumber Company, be and the same are hereby cancelled and that new certificates be issued in lieu thereof in accordance with the changes herein approved.
