On October 10, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Archie Reikkola, President, Lewis and Clark Seed Company, for approval of a change in place of use of water from Umatilla River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 10142, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of U.S. Reclamation Service, describes a right which includes the use of water from Umatilla River for irrigation of a certain 30.0 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 4 North, Range 24 East, WM, with a date of priority of March 28, 1909.

The right for supplemental irrigation of said 30.0 acres from the Columbia River, as described in Permit 33883, was to be transferred with the primary right to 30.0 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 24, Township 4 North, Range 24 East, WM.

The order of the Water Resources Director entered January 28, 1980, in Volume 32, pages 680 and 681, approving Transfer 4302, did not include a change in place of use of the supplemental right under Permit 33883.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the aforesaid order be amended to include a change in place of use of said supplemental right, and a certificate be issued confirming said supplemental right.
