ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6047 submitted by

HAROLD AKES
ROUTE 4, BOX 121
MILTON-FREEWATER, OREGON 97862

to use the waters of FOUR WELLS in the WALLA WALLA RIVER BASIN, for the purpose of DOMESTIC SUPPLY FOR 70 MOBILE HOMES AND TWO HOUSES INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF UP TO 1/2 ACRE LAWN OR NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN EACH.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 63617, was perfected under Permit G-10444 with a date of priority of JULY 6, 1984. This right is limited to 0.15 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.07 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.05 CFS FOR IRRIGATION OF LAWNS AND GARDENS FROM WELL E, WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN SUPPLY FROM WELLS A, C, AND D, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of appropriation from the source.

The new point of appropriation is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 25, T 6 N, R 35 E, W.M.; WELL E - 654 FEET SOUTH AND 921 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 SECTION 25

TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 35 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991.
- 2. When required by the Department, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 3. The well at the new point of appropriation shall be constructed to the well construction standards in effect as of the date of this order and must include an access port.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Certificate 63617 is canceled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
