ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION, PLACE OF USE, AND CHARACTER OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 TO 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6338 submitted by

PORTLAND GOLF CLUB 5900 S.W. SCHOLLS FERRY ROAD PORTLAND, OREGON 97255

to use the waters of FANNO CREEK, a tributary of the TUALATIN RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 96.78 ACRES AND MAINTAINING THE RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-11264 FOR RECREATION AND AESTHETICS DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 8186, was perfected under Permit 6089 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 13, 1923. This right is limited to 1.21 cubic feet per second for irrigation and 0.10 cfs for reservoir maintenance, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The new point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 24, T 1 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 1148 FEET SOUTH AND 819 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change is complete. The claim of beneficial use shall be submitted in accordance with the transmittal letter.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
- 3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right:

NOTE: 8.0 acres of this water right was changed from irrigation of former lands to reservoir maintenance.

Certificate 8186 was canceled by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 17, 1990 at Special Order Volume 44, Page 453 cancelling a portion of this water right. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right (including the unchanged portions) will be issued.
