ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN USE AND PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 537.705 and 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6965 submitted by

PORT OF MORROW P.O. BOX 200 BOARDMAN, OREGON 97818.

The right to be modified, AS EVIDENCED BY CERTIFICATE 47191, was perfected under Permit G-5332 with a date of priority of May 31, 1974. The right allows the use of a well, tributary of the Columbia River Basin, for Industrial Use (food processing). This right is limited to 2.0 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: NE¼ NW¼, Section 10, Township 4 N., Range 25 E., W.M. North 87° 23 minutes 05 seconds West 339.47 feet from the SE Corner, Lot 3, Block 1, Port of Morrow Food Processing Park, (a recorded Plat); or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

SW1/4 NW1/4
SE1/4 NW1/4
SECTION 10
TOWNSHIP 4 N., RANGE 25 E., WM

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the TYPE of use to MUNICIPAL USE and PLACE use to:

THE PORT OF MORROW SERVICE AREA NEAR BOARDMAN, OREGON

THESE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1995.
- 2. The use of water transferred for municipal use shall not exceed in any one year the peak amount of water actually used by the industry in any one of the last five years.
- When required by the Department, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans for the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Certificate 47191 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
