ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 9234 submitted by

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 46639, was perfected under Permit G-3270 with a date of priority of APRIL 25, 1966. The right allows the use of A WELL, in the FANNO CREEK BASIN, for MUNICIPAL USE. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.67 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; LOT 2(SW% NW%), SECTION 11, T 2 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 1625 FEET SOUTH AND 30 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 11, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

SECTION 16

The applicant proposes to change the point of appropriation to:

LOT 2 (SW1/4 NW1/4), SECTION 11, T 2 S, R 1 W, W.M.; SOUTH 00° 44' 37" WEST 1639 FEET FROM THE NW1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 11.

The applicant proposes an additional point of appropriation located:

LOT 2 (SW1/4 NW1/4), SECTION 11, T 2 S, R 1 W, W.M.; SOUTH 03° 13' 22" EAST 1561 FEET FROM THE NW1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 11.

THESE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 2008.
- The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully authorized under the right.
- 3. The water user shall install in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Certificate 46639 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
