## **Findings of Fact**

On January 25, 2002, PB Farms Incorporated filed an application to add an additional point of diversion under Certificate 76967. The Department assigned the application number T-8235.

On May 24, 2002, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving T-8235. This order was recorded in the Special Order Volume 56, Page 410.

On February 1, 2005, Patricia Lewis, Secretary-Treasurer of PB Farms Inc., notified the Department that the changes authorized through approval of transfer application T-8235 will not be completed and requested that the authorized point of diversion revert back to the original point of diversion.

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6010, the point of diversion shall revert to the last authorized point of diversion if the change is not completed.

## Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The point of diversion for the right affected by application T-8235 is reverted to the last authorized point of diversion prior to the transfer. A superseding certificate for the right affected by the transfer shall be issued.
