ORS 537.211 establishes the process in which a water right permit holder may submit a request to change the point of appropriation and/or place of use authorized under an existing water right permit.

### **Findings of Fact**

- On June 16, 2005, Roats Water System, Inc. filed an application for an additional point of appropriation under Permit G-12526. The Department assigned the application number T-9954.
- The permit to be amended is as follows:

3.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS); being 0.25 cfs from Well #3,

WELLS #3, #4, #9 and #10, in the DESCHUTES BASIN

Date of Complete Application of Water: OCTOBER 1, 2018

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

3. Application T-9954 proposes an additional point of appropriation under the permit, to be located approximately 1.75 miles from the original Well 10 site, as follows:

- 4. Notice of the application for permit amendment was published on the Department's weekly notice on July 5, 2005, and in a local newspaper on June 18, 2006, June 25, 2006 and July 2, 2006, pursuant to ORS 540.520(5). No comments were filed in response to the Department's weekly notice or to the newspaper notice.
- 5. The change would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 6. The change does not enlarge the permit.
- 7. The change does not alter any other terms of the permit.

## **Conclusions of Law**

The change in point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-9954 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

### Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The change and subsequent use of water shall be subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The combined quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (New Well 10), together with that diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the maximum rate and duty allowed under Permit G-12526.
- 2. Prior to water use from the proposed point of appropriation, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.

The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

- 3. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.
- 4. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-12526 remain the same.
- 5. Permit G-12526, in the name of Roats Water System, is amended as described herein.
