Findings of Fact

- 1. On April 18, 2002, City of Saint Paul filed an application to change the point of appropriation under Certificate 40213. The Department assigned the transfer application number T-9095.
- 2. On November 19, 2002, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving the proposed change in point of appropriation. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 56, Pages 2060-2062.
- 3. On July 11, 2014, City of Saint Paul notified the Department that the changes authorized under T-9095 would not be completed and requested that the authorized point of appropriation revert back to the original point of appropriation.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The point of appropriation authorized under Application T-9095 is reverted to the point of appropriation authorized under the water right prior to the transfer. A superseding certificate for the right affected by the transfer shall be issued.
