**Authority**

ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department’s procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

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**Findings of Fact**

1. On March 13, 2014, CITY OF ISLAND CITY filed an application for additional points of appropriation under Certificate 62005. The Department assigned the application number T-11760.
2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on March 25, 2014, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
3. On June 19, 2014, the applicant amended the application to include Certificate 89288 for additional points of appropriation.
4. On July 28, 2014, the applicant requested that the completion date be moved to October 1, 2024.
5. On July 28, 2014, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-11760 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of August 28, 2014, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

6. On August 29, 2014, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-11760 and sent a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published in the Department's weekly notice on September 9, 2014, and in the LeGrande Observer newspaper on September 5 and 12, 2014, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

7. The first right to be transferred is as follows:

**Certificate:** 62005 in the name of CITY OF ISLAND CITY (perfected under Permit G-7224)

**Use:** MUNICIPAL USES

**Priority Date:** FEBRUARY 24, 1977

**Rate:** 1.0 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

9. Transfer Application T-11760 proposes additional points of appropriation. Proposed Well No. 4 is approximately 0.6 mile from authorized Well No. 2 and 0.75 mile from authorized Well No. 1. Proposed Well No. 5 is approximately 0.55 mile from authorized Well No. 2 and approximately 0.8 mile from authorized Well No. 1. The location for the proposed wells are as follows:

12. Transfer Application T-11760 proposes additional points of appropriation. Proposed Well No. 5 is approximately 0.5 miles from authorized Well No. 4. The proposed location for Well No. 5 is as follows:

***Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)***

13. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
14. The groundwater section of the department has determined that the proposed points of appropriation meet all of the requirements of ORS 540.531 and OAR 690-280-2130(3) and (4).
15. A pump, pipeline, and steel tank reservoirs sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-11760.

**Conclusion of Law**

The additional points of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-11760 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

1. The additional points of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-11760 are approved.
2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 62005, 89288 and any related decree.
3. Water right certificates 62005 and 89288 are cancelled.
4. The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.
5. Water use measurement conditions:
  - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
  - b. The water user shall maintain the meters in good working order.
  - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters; provided however, where the meters are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
6. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

7. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2024**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
8. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.
