Authority

ORS 540.570 and 540.580 establishes the process in which a district may submit a request to transfer a water right within district boundaries. OAR Chapter 690, Division 385 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating district transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On February 11, 2016, the Department issued an order approving the changes in place of use associated with Transfer Application T-12245. This order is recorded in Special Order Volume 98, Pages 781-784.
- 2. Following issuance of the order, Department Staff noticed that the transfer map submitted did not match the application, upon further review the Department determined that the map was correct and the(to lands)or proposed lands should be described as in the table below with the changes made in bold and italic:

- 1. The order recorded in Special Order Volume 98, Pages 781-784 is corrected to identify the proposed place of use for Certificate 89006 as described in Finding of Fact #2.
- 2. All other provisions of the order are unchanged.
