confirms the right of record to use the waters of CRANE PRAIRIE RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-1687, tributary to the DESCHUTES RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 16.85 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-23256. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 28, 1913.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed a portion of the 50,000 acre-feet of stored water for the entire right, if available at the authorized point of diversion from the source, limited to the duty of water as set out in the modified supplemental decree of the circuit court dated March 24, 1933, in the matter of the determination of the relative rights to the use of the water of the Deschutes River and its tributaries. The amount of water allowed under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is further limited to the terms and the Central Oregon Irrigation District, Crook County Improvement District #1, and the Arnold Irrigation District, and subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

To prevent injury to instream water right Certificate 59778, water shall not be diverted for the allowed use whenever, during the irrigation season, flows in the Deschutes River at the point of diversion drop below 660 cfs.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.

This order is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 3, 2005, at Special Order Volume 66, Page 19, approving Transfer Application 9849, affecting a portion of Certificate 76714, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The Department will issue a superseding certificate describing the right when it determines that it is necessary for record keeping.
