## Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 540.570 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a district may submit a request to transfer a water right within district boundaries. Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 385 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating district transfer applications.

# **Background**

- 1. On November 15, 2000, Special Order Volume 54, Pages 826-834, a DETERMINATION AND ORDER APPROVING ALLOCATION AND ASSIGNMENT OF CONSERVED WATER (CW-9) was issued involving Tumalo Irrigation District's (TID) Certificates 74146, 74148 and 76106. On April 18, 2005, Special Order Volume 64, Pages 157-158, an ORDER FINALIZING THE ALLOCATION AND ASSIGNMENT OF CONSERVED under CW-9 was issued. This finding of fact clarifies the assignment of the conserved water under Certificates 74146 (primary irrigation) and 74148 (supplemental irrigation) to the place of use originally described under certificate 76106.
  - a. Consistent with these orders, the applicant's share of conserved water (11.3 cfs with a priority date of September 1900) under Certificate 74146<sup>1</sup> was assigned to serve the 790.6 acres originally associated with Certificate 76106. Consistent with the order, lands formerly under Certificate 76106 assigned to Certificate 74146 (790.6 acres) have a priority date of September 1909 for primary irrigation.
  - b. When the Department determines it is necessary for record keeping, it will issue a single superseding certificate for Certificate 74146. The superseding certificate will include both the place of use originally under Certificate 74146, and the place of use

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Within 20 days after this final order is issued (i.e., mailing date), the district or any protestant may file with the commission exceptions to the final order. The commission shall issue an order granting or denying the exceptions within 30 days after receiving the exceptions. ORS 540.580(10).

- (790.6 acres) formerly under Certificate 76106 now assigned to Certificate 74146, as modified by any transfers, including T-12810, completed pursuant to ORS 540.580.
- c. Also consistent with these orders, Certificate 76106 was cancelled with the issuance of confirming water right Certificate 81332 for the use of the waters of Tumalo Creek for instream use with priority date December 8, 1961, and the issuance of diminishment remaining right Certificate 88894 for use of the water of Upper Tumalo Reservoir for supplemental uses. Certificate 81332 was issued to the State of Oregon in exchange for TID receiving the State of Oregon's portion of conserved water under Certificate 74148.
- d. Thus, consistent with these orders, the entirety of the conserved water under Certificate 74148 (3,746 ac-ft) became the applicant's portion for supplemental irrigation under the same Certificate 74148. The conserved portion of water was assigned to serve the place of use (790.6 acres) described under Certificate 76106 for supplemental irrigation with the April 7, 1911 priority date.
- e. When the Department determines it is necessary for record keeping, it will issue a single superseding certificate for Certificate 74148 for supplemental irrigation. The superseding certificate will include both the place of use originally under Certificate 74148, and the place of use for the 790.6 acres as had been described in Certificate 76106, as modified by any transfers, including T-12810, completed pursuant to ORS 540.580.

# **Findings of Fact**

- 2. On December 28, 2017, TUMALO Irrigation District (TID) filed a district transfer application to permanently change the place of use under Certificates 74146, 74147, 74148, 74149, 76520, 76714, and 83571. The Department assigned the application number T-12810.
- 3. Notice of the District Permanent Transfer Application was published on January 9, 2018. No comments were filed in response to the notices.
- 4. On February 23, 2018, TID amended the application to reduce the proposed total number of acres, and on April 5, 2018, TID submitted superseding correcting tables. Amended maps for a portion of the transfer were submitted April 9, 2018.
- 5. The portion of the first right to be transferred is as follows:

**Certificate:** 74146 in the name of TUMALO IRRIGATION DISTRICT (confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Deschutes County)

Use: IRRIGATION of 36.6 ACRES and INDUSTRIAL USE of 2.0 ACRES EQUIVALENT

Priority Dates: SEPTEMBER 1900 and JUNE 1, 1907

Rate & Duty: The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SEVENTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 1.8 acre-feet, measure at or within one-half mile of the land to be irrigated, for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

# Maximum Quantity (Rate) that can be applied to an acre:

Season 1: Limited to 1/80 cubic foot per second (cfs) per acre

Season 2: Limited to 1/60 cfs per acre Season 3: Limited to 1/32.4 cfs per acre

## Maximum Duty that can be applied to an acre:

Not to exceed 9.91 acre-feet (af) per acre per year.

The above listed rates and duty reflect allowance of a 45% transmission loss as determined by decree of the Circuit Court of Deschutes County, dated March 24, 1933. Those lands not served from the district main canal systems, but by direct pumping from the Deschutes River, are not allowed the 45% transmission loss.

- 20. The Department finds that the district permanent transfer application was submitted according to ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4000, contains the information required under OARs 690-385-4200 and OAR 690-385-2000, and includes maps meeting the requirements of OARs 690-385-4300 and 690-385-2200.
- 21. The Department finds that the proposed district permanent transfer meets all the criteria set forth in ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4000.
- 22. The water right is subject to transfer as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(17).
- 23. The proposed change in places of use will not result in enlargement of the right as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(4).
- 24. The proposed change in place of use will not result in injury to other water rights as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(6).
- 25. Any other applicable requirements for district permanent water right transfers are met as required in OAR 690-385-4500.

#### **Conclusions of Law**

The proposed changes in place of use as proposed in Transfer Application T-12810 comply with and satisfy the requirements of ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4500.

# Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The proposed changes in place of use to the water rights evidenced by Certificates 74146, 74147, 74148, 74149, 76520, 76714, and 83571, are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use not modified by this order and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 74146, 74147, 74148, 74149, 76520, 76714, and 83571, and any related decree.
- 3. The proposed changes in place of use as proposed in Transfer Application T-12810 comply with and satisfy the requirements of ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4500.
- 4. The place of use from which the water right is removed by T-12810 shall no longer be irrigated under the transferred rights.
- 5. The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement device and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.
- 6. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before October 1, 2019. A Claim of Beneficial Use shall be submitted by TID to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 7. Water right Certificates 74146, 74147, 74148, 74149, 76520, 76714, and 83571, are modified. The Department will issue superseding certificates describing the rights when it determines it is necessary for record keeping.
