# Authority

ORS 540.570 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a district may submit a request to transfer a water right within district boundaries. OAR Chapter 690, Division 385 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating district transfer applications.

#### Background

- On November 15, 2000, Special Order Volume 54, Pages 826-834, a DETERMINATION AND ORDER APPROVING ALLOCATION AND ASSIGNMENT OF CONSERVED WATER (CW-9) was issued involving TID's Certificates 74146, 74148 and 76106. On April 18, 2005, Special Order Volume 64, Pages 157-158, an Order Finalizing the Allocation and Assignment of Conserved under CW-9 was issued. This background finding of fact clarifies the assignment of the conserved water under Certificates 74146 (primary irrigation) and 74148 (supplemental irrigation) to the place of use originally described under Certificate 76106.
  - a. Consistent with these orders, the applicant's share of conserved water (11.3 cfs with a priority date of September 1900) under Certificate 74146¹ was assigned to serve the 790.6 acres originally associated with Certificate 76106. Consistent with the order, lands formerly under Certificate 76106 assigned to Certificate 74146 (790.6 acres) have a priority date of September 1909 for primary irrigation.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Within 20 days after this final order is issued (i.e., mailing date), the district or any protestant may file with the commission exceptions to the final order. The commission shall issue an order granting or denying the exceptions within 30 days after receiving the exceptions. ORS 540.580(10).

- b. When the Department determines it is necessary for record keeping, it will issue a single superseding certificate for Certificate 74146. The superseding certificate will include both the place of use originally under Certificate 74146, and the place of use (790.6 acres) formerly under Certificate 76106 now assigned to Certificate 74146, as modified by any transfers, including T-11504, completed pursuant to ORS 540.580.
- c. Also consistent with these orders, Certificate 76106 was cancelled with the issuance of confirming water right Certificate 81332 for the use of the waters of Tumalo Creek for instream use with priority date December 8, 1961, and the issuance of diminishment remaining right Certificate 88894 for use of the water of Upper Tumalo Reservoir for supplemental uses. Certificate 81332 was issued to the State of Oregon in exchange for TID receiving the State of Oregon's portion of conserved water under Certificate 74148.
- d. Thus, consistent with these orders, the entirety of the conserved water under Certificate 74148 (3,746 ac-ft) became the applicant's portion for supplemental irrigation under the same Certificate 74148. The conserved portion of water was assigned to serve the place of use (790.6 acres) described under Certificate 76106 for supplemental irrigation with the April 7, 1911 priority date.
- e. When the Department determines it is necessary for record keeping, it will issue a single superseding certificate for Certificate 74148 for supplemental irrigation. The superseding certificate will include both the place of use originally under Certificate 74148, and the place of use for the 790.6 acres as had been described in Certificate 76106, as modified by any transfers, including T-11504, completed pursuant to ORS 540.580.

# Findings of Fact

- On December 19, 2012, Tumalo Irrigation District filed a district transfer application to permanently change the place of use under Certificates 74146, 74147, 74148, 74149, 76106 and 76520. The Department assigned the application number T-11504.
- 3. Notice of the application for transfer was published on December 24, 2012, pursuant to ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4400. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 4. On March 21, 2013, the Department signed a final order, which was mailed on April 3, 2013, approving Transfer Application for T-11504. The final order was recorded in Special Order Volume 89, Pages 182-187.
- 5. Transfer T-11504 was issued after the issuance date, being April 18, 2005, of the Order Finalizing the Allocation and Assignment of Conserved under CW-9, referenced in Background Item #1, above.
  - The final order for Transfer T-11504 was issued without including the place of use changes to Certificate 74148 for supplemental irrigation as affected by Special Order

Volume 64, Pages 157-258 (place of use formerly under Certificate 76106). This superseding correcting order is, in part, issued to correct omission of these places of use in the original order issued on May 13, 2013. All lands under Certificate 74148 as affected by Special Order Volume 64, Pages 157-258 (place of use formerly described under Certificate 76106) which were omitted in the original final order are layered with places of use identical to lands under Certificate 74146² for primary irrigation, and Certificates 74149 and 76520 for supplemental irrigation.

- b. The place of use changes to Certificate 74146 for primary irrigation as affected by Special Order Volume 64, Pages 157-258 (place of use formerly under Certificate 76106) was included in transfer T-11504 as primary irrigation under Certificate 76106. This superseding correcting order is, in part issued to correct references to Certificate 76106 (cancelled as of April 18, 2005) to Certificate 74146 with a priority date of September 1900.
- 6. In reviewing the original final order for T-11504, Special Order Volume 89 at Page 182-187, it was also discovered that not all parcels for supplement irrigation for Certificates 74148 and 74149 were included. Omitted lands for supplemental irrigation are layered with lands for primary irrigation under Certificate 74146² approved in the original order. This superseding correcting order is, in part, issued to correct omission of these places of use in the original order issued on May 13, 2013. These corrections are consistent with the transfer application.
- 7. This order is issued to supersede the original Final Order recorded at Special Order Volume 89, Pages 182-187 and to correct additional scrivener's errors not itemized above. Changes to the original order will be shown in **Bold and Italic**. Deletions will be shown in strikeout text.
- 8. The portion of the first right to be transferred is as follows:

Priority Date: September 1900 and June 1, 1907

Rate & Duty: The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured

under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SEVENTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 1.8 acre-feet, measured at or within one-half mile of the land to be irrigated,

for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

of not to exceed 9.91 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and the right allowed hereunder for the appropriation of water for lands having a valid prior right shall be limited to the amount necessary to make up any deficiency in water available to said lands under said prior right and the amount allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for said lands, shall be limited by the duty of water as fixed herein,; and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

- 17. The district permanent transfer application satisfies the criteria of OAR 690-385-4000, contains the information required under OAR 690-385-2000, and includes maps meeting the requirements of OAR 690-385-2200.
- 18. The water rights are subject to transfer as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(17).
- 19. The proposed change in place of use would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 20. The proposed change in place of use would not result in injury to other water rights

#### Conclusions of Law

The proposed changes in place of use in Transfer Application T-11504 satisfy the requirements of ORS 540.574(3) and 540.580.

# Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The proposed changes to the water rights evidenced by Certificates 74146, 74147, 74148, 74149, <del>76106</del> and 76520 are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 74146, 74147, 74148, 74149, <del>76106</del> and 76520 and any related decree.
- The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of these water rights.
- The proposed change, as authorized by this final order, shall be completed within one full year from the approval date plus any additional time before or until October 1, 2013.
- Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before October 1, 2014. A Claim of Beneficial Use shall be submitted to the Department by Tumalo Irrigation District within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 6. Certificates 74146, 74147, 74148, 74149, <del>76106</del> and 76520 are modified. The Department will issue superseding certificates describing the right when it determines that is necessary for record keeping.
