On April 27, 1962 Multnomah County did file a petition in the office of the State Engineer requesting that they be allowed to register an irrigation well under the provisions of ORS 537.605.

Multnomah County failed to register this well during the registration period ending August 4, 1958. The well was constructed in October 1951 and first used for irrigation in June 1952. The well is located at the Juvenile Home and is covered by State Permit No. G-1161. Its location is N 42° 54' W 2210 feet from the center of Section 32 being within the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 32, Township 1 North, Range 2 East, W.M. The quantity of water claimed is 300 gallons per minute and it is used to sprinkle lawn areas near the Home.

It appears that Multnomah County has a vested ground water right that would be subject to determination under ORS 537.670 to 537.695.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that Multnomah County is authorized to register their irrigation well in accordance with the procedures set forth in ORS 537.605.
