Findings of Fact

1. On October 2, 2012, McClain Village Water Department Inc. filed an application for a permit to use the public waters of the State of Oregon with the Water Resources Department.
2. On January 24, 2014, the Department issued a Final Order and draft permit. Issuance of a permit was contingent on the Department receiving documentation that Well 1 (MARI 4777/MARI 6683) complies with minimum well construction standards. The Final Order gave the applicant 60 days to submit the documentation.
3. On July 17, 2018 and December 16, 2020, the Department again requested evidence of well construction compliance and gave the applicant 60 days to submit the documentation.
4. As of this date, the applicant has not submitted the required information.


Conclusions of Law
