## BEFORE THE WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR OF OREGON

Clackamas County

IN THE MATTER OF AN EXTENSION OF TIME WITHIN WHICH TO BEGIN AND COMPLETE CONSTRUCTION AND MAKE COMPLETE APPLICATION OF WATER UNDER PERMIT G-6023 IN THE NAME OF RIVERGROVE WATER DISTRICT.

River Grove Water District is the holder of Permit G-6023 which grants the right to appropriate not to exceed 1.0 cubic foot of water per second from River Grove Water District Well No. 3 for municipal purposes.

The District has advised the Water Resources Director that the appropriation of water has not been made as described in the permit, but it is their desire to preserve the right for this development.

The District also advised that the construction of a well started on March 6, 1974 was abandoned because of an inadequate water supply. An assessment will have to be made to determine the probability for getting water by further drilling.

It is believed that it will be consistent with the public interest to grant the extension for which application has been made.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the time limits in which to begin and complete construction and make complete application of water be extended to October 1, 1980.
