The City of Yachats is the holder of Permits 29018 and 35219 which grants the right to appropriate not to exceed 2.0 cubic feet of water per second from Salmon Creek and 3.0 cubic feet of water per second from Marks Creek for municipal use.


The District has advised the Water Resources Director that the appropriation has not been made as described in the permit, but it is the District's desire to preserve the right for this development.

The District has further advised that they have done some surveying and planning and are preparing for a bond vote.

It is believed that it will be consistent with the public interest to grant said extension.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the time limits to begin and complete construction and make complete application of water under Permits 29018 and 35219 be extended to October 1, 1987.
