On June 8, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Jack Vogt for approval of a change in place of use of water from Tumalo Creek, Deschutes River, Crater Creek, Little Crater Creek and three spring branches, and Crescent Lake Reservoir, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The order of the Water Resources Director approving said transfer of water right was entered September 25, 1981 at page 238, Volume 35, Special Order Record.

On April 13, 1984, statements were received from Tumalo Irrigation District; Jack Vogt, the applicant; Kendall Kruse, the recipient of 5.0 acres of water right and Kuhlman J. Miller stating that the original intent of the transfer application was to place 4.0 acres of water right on Tax Lot 900, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 19, Township 16 South, Range 12 East, WM (Kendall Kruse) and 1.0 acre of water right on Tax Lot 300, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 11, Township 17 South, Range 11 East, WM (Kulhman J. Miller).

It appearing that the original intent was to allow Kendall Kruse 4.0 acres of water right and to allow Kulhman J. Miller 1.0 acre of water right, and it appearing that the change may be made without injury to existing rights, the amendment should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the order approving Transfer Application 4237 be amended to place 4.0 acres of water right with a priority date of October 29, 1913 on Tax Lot 900, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 19, Township 16 South, Range 12, East, WM (Kendall Kruse) and 1.0 acre with a priority date of October 29, 1913 on Tax Lot 300, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 11, Township 17 South, Range 11 East, WM (Kulhman J. Miller).

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the water right involved in this amending order be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1984.
