from the Harlan Sanders Ditch, which is the authorized point of diversion, and from an additional point of diversion to be located 1590 feet North and 1210 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 23, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 22, Township 6 South, Range 39 East, WM.

The order of the Water Resources Director, entered August 11, 1980, approving Transfer Application 4465, provided "...that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1,1981."

The applicant has failed to make proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director that the proposed change was accomplished within the provisions of the order, therefore, the right to divert at the proposed additional point of diversion has been lost. The aforesaid Harlan Sanders Ditch is the only authorized point of diversion.
