Affidavits were received from DON DODSON, JESSIE DODSON, LOUISE DODSON and ZELDA JOY HARROD, the owners of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The water right has been abandoned and is requested to be canceled.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order cancelling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the portion of the water right described herein is cancelled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate 1790 is cancelled and a new certificate be issued for that portion of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
