ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.211, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, PERMIT AMENDMENT T-7732 submitted by

DAVID ALAN SNODGRASS
3944 SW HALCYON ROAD
TUALATIN, OREGON 97062.

The permit to be modified is Permit G-12150 with a date of priority of JULY 23, 1990. The permit allows the use of TWO WELLS, in the SAUM CREEK BASIN, for AGRICULTURAL USE AND IRRIGATION OF 12.2 ACRES. The amount of water to which this permit is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.49 cubic foot per second (CFS), BEING 0.36 CFS FROM WELL 1 (BASALT AQUIFER) and 0.13 CFS FROM WELL 2 (ALLUVIAL AQUIFER), if available at the original wells; WELL 1 - SE¼ SW¼, SECTION 20, T 2 S, R 1 E, W.M.; 592 FEET SOUTH AND 1456 FEET EAST FROM THE S 1/16 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 19 AND 20, WELL 2 - SW¼ SW¼, SECTION 20, T 2 S, R 1 E, W.M.; 139 FEET SOUTH AND 1067 FEET EAST FROM THE S 1/16 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 19 AND 20, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells. Use of water from Well 2 is limited to the period November 1 through April 30.

The amount of water used for AGRICULTURAL USE is limited to a diversion of 0.15 cubic foot per second per acre. For the irrigation of **containerized nursery plants**, the amount of water diverted is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 5.0 acre feet per acre per year. For the irrigation of **in-ground nursery plants** the amount of water diverted is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre feet per acre per year. The use of water for AGRICULTURAL USE may be at any time of the year that the use is beneficial. For the irrigation of **any other crop**, the amount of water diverted is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year. The period of allowed use for irrigation is March 1 through October 31.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

SW¼ SW¼ 9.5 ACRES
SE¼ SW¼ 2.7 ACRES
SECTION 20
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes an additional point of appropriation to:

WELL 3 (BASALT AQUIFER) - SW¼ SW¼, SECTION 20, T 2 S, R 1 E, W.M.; 30 FEET SOUTH AND 708 FEET EAST OF THE S 1/16 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 19 AND 20.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER PERMIT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.
2. Water shall be acquired from the same basalt aquifer as in Well 1, an original point of appropriation.
3. All other terms and conditions of the permit remain the same.

Permit G-12150, in the name of DAVID ALAN SNODGRASS is amended as described herein.
