The rights to be modified are portions of certificate 74197. The source is the Deschutes River, a tributary of the Columbia River. The dates of priority are February 1, 1905 for 25.0 cubic feet per second and April 25, 1905 for 125.0 cfs.

These lands also have a supplemental right from Crane Prairie Reservoir under permit 23256. The date of priority is February 28, 1913.

- 3 The former places of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of these water rights.
- Except as modified herein, all other conditions and restrictions of Certificate 74197 and 4. Permit 23256 remain in effect.
- When the Director determines that it is necessary, or to facilitate records keeping, new 5. certificates will be issued to confirm all completed changes for which satisfactory proof has been made and to confirm that portion of the right not modified by this or any other order.
