ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.211, after notice was given and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, PERMIT AMENDMENT T-9365 submitted by

SPRINGFIELD UTILITY BOARD 202 SOUTH 18TH SPRINGFIELD, OREGON 97477.

The permit to be modified is Permit G-2643 with a date of priority of JUNE 8, 1964. The permit allows the use of TWO WELLS, in the WILLAMETTE RIVER BASIN, for QUASI-MUNICIPAL USE. The amount of water to which this permit is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second, if available at the original wells; SE% SE%, SECTION 6, T 18 S, R 2 W, W.M.; WELL 1 - 600 FEET SOUTH AND 250 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF HARPER DLC 66; WELL 2 -650 FEET SOUTH AND 110 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF HARPER DLC 66, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

NE¼ E½ NW¼ E½ SW¼ SE¼ SECTION 6

NW¼ NW¼ SECTION 7

TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the point of appropriation to:

NW¼ SW¼, SECTION 6, T 18 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 1452 FEET SOUTH AND 212 FEET EAST OF THE SSW CORNER OF BRIGGS DLC 39.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER PERMIT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well) shall not exceed the maximum rate and duty allowed under the water right permit.
- The water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an inline flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

- 3. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
- 4. The proposed point of appropriation shall be constructed no deeper than 70 feet below land surface.
- 5. All other terms and conditions of the permit remain the same.

Permit G-2643, in the name of SPRINGFIELD UTILITY BOARD is amended as described herein.
