## **Findings of Fact**

- 1. Boring Water District No. 24, filed an application to add points of appropriation to Permit G-13882. The Department assigned the application number T-9713.
- 2. The permit to be amended is as follows:

**Permit**: G-13882, in the name of Boring Water District No. 24;

Use: Municipal Priority Date: July 11, 2000

**Quantity:** 6.04 cubic feet per second

**Source:** Two wells, in the Johnson Creek Basin.

Date Of Complete Application of

Water: October 1, 2005

- 4. Notice of the application for permit amendment was published pursuant to ORS 540.520(5). No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 5. The change would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 6. The change does not enlarge the permit.
- 7. The change does not alter all other terms of the permit.

#### **Conclusions of Law**

The additional points of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-9713 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

## Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The change and subsequent use of water shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. The combined quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation (wells), together with that diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the maximum quantity of water allowed under Permit G-13882.

2. Prior to water use from the proposed points of appropriation, the permittee shall install meters or other suitable measuring devices as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.

The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within private structures, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

- 3. Water shall be acquired from the same Lower Troutdale aquifer as the original points of appropriation.
- 4. The proposed points of appropriation shall be constructed so as to only acquire water from the Lower Troutdale aquifer. The proposed well shall be cased and sealed through the entire Upper Troutdale aquifer and also shall be constructed in such a manner as to prevent water from entering the proposed wells from water bearing formations below the Lower Troutdale aquifer.
- 5. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-13882 remain the same.
- 6. Permit G-13882, in the name of Boring Water District No. 24, is amended as described herein.
