Findings of Fact

- On September 10, 2007, the Department received an application for extension of time for transfer of water right T-10102 from Dan Butts for the City of Portland, Parks and Recreation.
- 2. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-10102 in the name of City of Portland, Parks and Recreation c/o Dan Butts, on August 8, 2006. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 69, at Page 590. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2007.
- 3. The applicant has installed an approved fish screen. The intake line from the creek to the casting pond reservoir has been installed. The overflows device and line from the reservoir to the pump station has been installed. The new pump station has been installed, and the power line to the pump station is partially installed.
- 4. To fully complete the change, it will be necessary for the applicant to complete installation of the new power line to the new pump station. The new electrical cabinet must be installed and the power to the new pump station must be connected. New discharge lines from the new pump station to the existing irrigation system must be installed and connected.
- 5. The landowner has requested that the time for completion of beneficial use be extended to October 1, 2008.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-10102.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of beneficial use authorized by T-10102 shall be extended to October 1, 2008.
