Authority

ORS 540.570 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a district may submit a request to transfer a water right within district boundaries. OAR Chapter 690, Division 385 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating district transfer applications.

Applicant

Findings of Fact

- 1. On December 15, 2011, Tumalo Irrigation District filed a district transfer application to permanently change the place of use under Certificates 74146, 74147, 74148, 74149, 76106 and 76520. The Department assigned the application number T-11329.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published pursuant to ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4400. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. The portion of the first right to be transferred is as follows:

each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

Rate & Duty: The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of not to exceed 9.91 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and the right allowed hereunder for the appropriation of water for lands having a valid prior right shall be limited to the amount necessary to make up any deficiency in water available to said lands under said prior right and the amount allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for said lands, shall be limited by the duty of water as fixed herein,; and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

- 17. The district permanent transfer application satisfies the criteria of OAR 690-385-4000, contains the information required under OAR 690-385-2000, and includes maps meeting the requirements of OAR 690-385-2200.
- 18. The water rights are subject to transfer as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(17).
- 19. The proposed change in place of use would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 20. The proposed change in place of use would not result in injury to other water rights

Conclusions of Law

The proposed changes in place of use in Transfer Application T-11329 satisfy the requirements of ORS 540.574(3) and 540.580.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The proposed changes to the water rights evidenced by Certificates 74146, 74147, 74148, 74149, 76106 and 76520.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 74146, 74147, 74148, 74149, 76106 and 76520 and any related decree.
- 3. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this water right.
- 4. The proposed change, as authorized by this final order, shall be completed within one full year from the approval date plus any additional time before or until October 1, 2013.
- 5. A Claim of Beneficial Use shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department by October 1, 2014.
- 6. Certificates 74146, 74147, 74148, 74149, 76106 and 76520 are modified. The Department will issue superseding certificates describing the right when it determines that is necessary for record keeping.
