### **Findings of Fact**

- 1. On November 16, 2001, the Department issued a final order, recorded in Special Order Volume 55, Pages 1230-1234, approving transfer application T-7530.
- 2. On May 8, 2003, the Department received a Claim of Beneficial Use (CBU), prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner, for Transfer Application T-7530.
- 3. The Department reviewed the CBU and maps submitted for Transfer Application T-7530.
- 4. The CBU did not contain map(s) of the point(s) of diversion from the source. However, since the transfer did not involve changes in point of diversion, the existing map(s) on file with the Department are sufficient to identify the point(s) of diversion from the source.
- 5. Satisfactory proof of the changes was submitted with evidence showing that water was fully used in the location and for the purpose as authorized by the final order approving Transfer Application T-7530.

#### **Conclusions of Law**

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6040, the Department may issue a certificate upon a determination that the application of water to beneficial use under the terms of the final order approving a permanent district transfer was completed to the extent authorized.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

## Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The Department has determined that the application of water to beneficial use under the terms of the final order approving Transfer Application T-7530 was completed to the extent authorized.
- 2. Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6040, the Department will issue water right certificates on a determination that it is necessary to produce certificates describing the rights.
