Authority

ORS 540.570 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a district may submit a request to transfer a water right within district boundaries. OAR Chapter 690, Division 385 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating district transfer applications.

Applicant

TUMALO IRRIGATION DISTRICT 64697 COOK AVE. BEND, OR 97701

Findings of Fact

- 1. On December 19, 2013, Tumalo Irrigation District filed a district transfer application to permanently change the place of use under Certificates 74146, 74147, and 76106. The Department assigned the application number T-11701.
- 2. On April 18, 2005, Special Order Volume 64, Pages 157-158, Allocation of Conserved Water CW-9 was approved. This order supersedes the portion of Certificate 76106 involved with T-11701.
- 3. Special Order Volume 64, Pages 157-158, cancelled Certificate 76106 and described the portion of conserved water from Tumalo Creek with the priority date of September 1, 1900, now to serve the lands originally associated with Certificate 76106.
- 4. Notice of the application for transfer was published on December 31, 2013, pursuant to ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4400. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 5. The portion of the first right to be transferred is as follows:

Certificate: 74146, issued in the name of Tumalo Irrigation District

Use: Irrigation of 10.11 acres

Priority Date: September 1, 1900, June 1, 1907, May 27, 1907, August 5, 1900

Rate & Duty: The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SEVENTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 1.8 acre-feet, measure at or within one-half mile of the land to be irrigated, for

each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

Source: Tumalo Creek, tributary to the Deschutes River

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Rate & Duty: The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured

Apr 1 to May 1 and Oct 1 to Nov 1 -1/80 cfs per acre

May 1 to May 15 and Sep 15 to Oct 1-1/60 cfs

May 15 to Sep 15 1/32.4 cfs, and 9.91 total acre-feet per acre at the diversion

during the season.

- 11. The district permanent transfer application satisfies the criteria of OAR 690-385-4000, contains the information required under OAR 690-385-2000, and includes maps meeting the requirements of OAR 690-385-2200.
- 12. The water rights are subject to transfer as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(17).
- 13. The proposed change in place of use would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 14. The proposed change in place of use would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The proposed changes in place of use as proposed in Transfer Application T-11701 satisfy the requirements of ORS 540.574(3) and 540.580.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The proposed changes to the water rights evidenced by Certificates 74146, 74147, 76106, and Special Order Volume 64, Pages 157-158.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 74146, 74147, 76106, Special Order Volume 64, Pages 157-158, and any related decree.
- 3. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of these water rights.
- 4. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2015**. A Claim of Beneficial Use shall be submitted by Tumalo Irrigation District to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 6. Water Right certificates 74146, 74147, 76106 and Special Order Volume 64, Pages 157-158 are modified. The Department will issue superseding certificates describing the rights when it determines that is necessary for record keeping.
