DETERMINATION OF SATISFACTORY PROOF

Authority

ORS 540.530 and OAR 690-385-7600 describe the process for the Water Resources Department is issue or modify a water right certificate upon determination that an applicant has made satisfactory proof of the completion of the changes.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On February 21, 2013, the Department issued a final order, recorded in Special Order Volume 89, Pages 46 50, approving Transfer Application T-11510. The order established October 1, 2014, as the date for completion of the authorized changes in place of use.
- 2. On October 2, 2015, the Department received a Claim of Beneficial Use (CBU) and associated maps for Transfer Application T-11510, from the applicant.
- 3. The CBU did not contain a map of the point of diversion from the source. However, since the transfer involved the transfer of places of use only within an irrigation district and did not involve a change in the point of diversion, the existing maps on file with the Department are sufficient to identify the point of diversion from the source.
- 4. The CBU and associated maps for a portion of this transfer illustrates that a portion of the authorized place of use change was proved up on slightly differently than authorized. This change is described further in the tables below: As authorized in the order:

- 6. The reconfigured changes in place of use as mapped and described above are determined satisfactory because the reconfiguration does not enlarge the right and the water right holder remains the same.
- 7. Satisfactory proof of the changes was submitted with evidence showing that water was used in the location and for the purpose as authorized by the final order approving Transfer Application T-11510.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to ORS 540.530 and OAR 690-385-7600, the Department may issue or modify a certificate upon a determination the application of water to beneficial use under the terms of the final order approving a permanent district transfer was completed to the extent authorized.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The water has been applied to beneficial use to the extent authorized under the terms of the final order approving Transfer Application T-11510.
- 2. Water right certificates 83571 and 76714 are modified. The Department shall issue water right certificates on a determination that it is necessary to produce certificates describing the water rights.
